

What is the United Arts Council of Collier County?

- The United Arts Council is designated by the state of Florida as the official local arts agency for Collier County
- The Council's programs are focused in two general areas:
 - Uniting and promoting the entire arts community
 - Providing arts education to at-risk students, and outreach services to the community
- Major programs and activities currently include:
 - Art education – teaching art, music, dance, digital film-making and theatre in after-school programs for at-risk public school students
 - Immokalee outreach – providing classes in the arts to Immokalee children and at-risk teens
 - Public information – The Council serves as an arts information clearinghouse, publishing the most comprehensive cultural calendar in the county (www.collierarts.com)
- The Council receives no funding from local governments and is dependent upon donations from individuals and businesses to continue its work
