
WE'RE AT THE HEART OF THE ARTS

UAC sponsors free after-school programs at eight locations in music, dance, art, film, and more, for over 1,200 at-risk public school students who would otherwise not have an opportunity to learn about the arts. We conduct Summer Art Camps and provide artist residencies at schools and social service agencies, as well as free music and dance performances and Family Art Nights in underserved areas of the county.

United Arts Council connects arts organizations, artists, galleries and arts educators with one another,

> with local audiences, and with tourism-related businesses. We offer educational and informational programs for member artists, arts teachers, galleries and arts organizations, and coordinate exhibit opportunities for emerging artists.
